Text: There are logical reasons to believe in God's existence.

Big Idea: John 1:1-5

Video question...

We talked about a few reasons why people reject God's existence. Why do you think people reject the existence of God from your experience?

1. When you read about or hear someone deny the existence of God how do you normally respond? How do you control your emotions since it's such an emotional topic?
2. What evidence for God's existence helped you move toward faith in God?
3. When are the most compelling arguments you hear against God's existence from people you know or have read?
4. When you think about arguments for God (morality, cosmological, or design) which one helps you have assurance of the reality of God? Which one would you use talking to a friend that does not believe in God?
5. What do you think your response would be when people mock you for your belief in God? What did Jesus tell us about persecution? How should we respond?
6. Read John 1:1-5 together as a group. Process all the implications about Jesus found in this text.
7. This week would you as a group take time and pray for someone you know that has rejected God's existence. Pray for them specifically. Pray that God will use the Holy Spirit to open their eyes and give them guidance.
