

Oct. 21 / The Problem of Hell Text: Luke 13:2-30

Video Question: When you were growing up what were you taught about heaven and hell?

- 1. We easily embrace heaven, we even say our pets are in heaven! Why is hell so difficult for us?
- 2. What rejection of hell have you embraced before or have heard embraced by others? (it's repulsive, unjust, overkill, or a torture chamber)
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 13:2 together. How does this idea from Paul impact how we deal with the issue of hell?
- 4. How does the reality that Jesus spoke about divine judgement and hell often impact your view of hell?
- 5. Read Luke 13:22 together as a group. What is discouraging about this passage and what is encouraging?
- 6. God is equally loving and just. Why is it so easy to embrace the love of God and not the justness of God?
- 7. Our pictures of heaven and hell are not helpful. Heaven is to be in God's presence and hell is separation from God. How does this help you think about hell?
- 8. God never rejoices over hell. Read John 3:16 together as a group and talk about God's rescue effort toward mankind! Spend time praying for friends you know who are not followers of Jesus.
