John 19:16-18, 28-30

- The resurrection changes everything. It is the heartbeat of our Christian faith. It validates everything Jesus ever taught or did. It separates us from any other religion.
- Do you find yourself ever lost in the past or in the future? How does this affect you in the present? How does the word of God speak into your present situation right now?
- Can you admit to the group where you struggle with insecurities and discontentment? What does the resurrection say to these struggles?
- Can you think of a promise of God from the message that you can memorize and speak over yourself on a daily basis?
- Jesus is enough because of the cross. What are you adding to the gospel, to the cross of Jesus Christ, that truly is enough?
- In your own words, can you explain substitutionary atonement? How can knowing that through faith you are right with God change your daily thought life?
- The work of Jesus is complete. He declares this and invites us to live in his finished work. What struggle or sin will you seek to apply this in your life?
- Where are you trying to “save yourself” apart from the finished work of Christ? What we forget is that in Christ we have everything we need. Our identity is in Christ!
- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.
