



The Sermon on the Mount-Matthew 7:7-11

- Do you want to see a movement of God? Do you personally need a fresh wind of God's grace in your life?
- Do you really believe that prayer moves God's hand? How is this evidenced in the persistence of your prayer? Is this Scripture of asking evident in your life?
- Ask in humility. Seek in action. Knock with perseverance. Is there effort in your prayer life, from persistence in prayer to stepping out in faith as you see God moving?
- Do you ask, seek, and knock for the greater things, namely spiritual growth in us and others, and that God's name would be glorified no matter what? At the same time, can you rest in God's sovereign goodness and control?
- Do you know that as God's child he constantly delights in you, always has your best in mind, and will always do what is best for you? Let these truths fuel your prayer life, therefore your relationship with God your Father.
- If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him! Matthew 7:11
