

Behold! Matthew 2:13-26

- Did you identify through the sermon something that you have allowed to rule your heart rather than Jesus? This was Herod, who was a power hungry, evil man, and would go to extreme measures to get his way. What about you, have you done malicious things to get your way, knowing that it was against God's will?
- In the midst of turmoil, Jesus steps in to bring peace and order. Where do you need Jesus to step into your turmoil? Have you submitted this area to him fully, and prayed faithfully concerning this?
- When have you seen God step into an area of your life and change you in the midst of it, instead of changing the circumstance? Will you look back at this to give you future faith for the unknowns that will inevitably come?
- When we ask "what" and not "why" in the midst of a trial, we gain clarity and God's perspective. So we can ask, "What is God doing here"? "What can I do", and "what is my response to this situation"?
- God desires to be intimately involved in every area of your life.
- Remember Jesus' words, "Behold, I am with you always" and "Behold, I stand at the door and knock".
