ACTS 16:25-34

God gave us a clear directive in Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV)

18 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19** Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in[a] the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

If we are going to go out into the world and do what God has entrusted us to do then we really need to be honest and evaluate our relationship with Jesus.

Questions:

1. Think about your day today. Were you in conversation with Jesus at any point during the day? Do you wait for a crisis or a need before praying?
2. What does it look like for each one of us to go out into the world and make disciples of others? How are you doing this? If you are not, how can you start making this a priority in your life as a believer?
3. Think about specific examples as to how you can you can pray for these things in your life:
 - a. Awareness - What does God want me to do?
 - b. Opportunity - How can I keep my ears and eyes open to see opportunities that allow me to point people to Jesus?
 - c. People - Who can I pray for specifically?
 - d. Courage - How can I break through my own fear and model how Jesus is working in my own life for people to see?
